# 1. WORK AREA AND CLIENT PREPARATION, AND SET UP OF SUPPLIES (15 minutes)

- 2.1 Thermal curling supplies are labeled in English (If original manufacturer's label is present, it must have English and may be multi-language, any other created label must be only English)
- 2.2 Implements and supplies are visibly clean
- 2.3 Tests temperature of iron
- 2.4 Subsections hair for thermal curling
- 2.5 Uses iron safely
- 2.6 Final appearance of four curls
- 2.7 Maintains drape throughout section
- 2.8 Items to be disinfected, soiled linens, and trash are disposed of in a correct manner throughout section

- 15.5 Holds skin taut (without slack)
- 15.6 Demonstrates tweezing of hair in direction of hair growth


