- The County Administrator, Jason Ward, has been contacted regarding property in the District 2 area. He is meeting with the Economic Development Board about two possible sites in the lower county.
- New camera replacements have been ordered and installation scheduled over the next few weeks.
- We are in the process of replacing computers and i-pads.
- The printer in Human Resources/Payroll has been replaced.
- 25 new additional chromebooks have been purchased for Diesel and Machine Technology.
- A new touch screen TV has been installed in Carpentry.
- The video walls are in and will be installed at both locations.
- The new truck has been ordered and will be delivered to Lexington's commercial vehicle lot and available for pick up next Thursday. The Expedition has been ordered with an estimated delivery date in June.
- We have advertised for the new Agriculture position, Ag Mechanization. One candidate has expressed interest in the position.
- Teachers have received their budget packets for updates and additional equipment needs. A zoom meeting for our budget has been scheduled for April 20 at 1:00 p.m. with the County. It was the decision of the Board to schedule a meeting to discuss the budget on March 30 at 1:00 p.m. after the Industrial Council meeting.

- On Saturday the seniors are going to the Sporting Clays State Competition.
